On June 6th, State Rep. Perry Warren (D-Bucks), Pennsylvania Physician General Rachel Levine, and members of the National Eating Disorders Association gathered at the Capitol to spotlight Warren's bill to bring awareness to eating disorders. PaPS Executive Director Deb Shoemaker was in attendance in support of the bill.
